

TABLE 3.6 NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR CHILD CARE SUBSIDY – INCOME ELIGIBILITY<sup>a</sup>

The Newfoundland and Labrador child care subsidy is for moderate and low-income families. Families with a combined net income of less than \$35K are eligible for full-subsidy. The amount of subsidy payments is determined by income levels.<sup>a</sup>
