Kindergarten Completion of a four-year bachelor of education degree that includes course work and
Teachersa classroom observation and teaching is required, or Kindergarten certification consisting of a
two-year program in ECE, successful completion of two academic years of classroom teaching,
and completion of courses for one-year teacher training, or a letter of authority that must be
renewed annually.

Most Kindergarten teachers have a bachelor of education or a letter of authority as a language
specialist, which means that they speak an Inuit language.
