Kindergarten Teachers

A bachelor's degree in education; course work should include mathematics, language arts, social studies, science, health, physical education, art, and music. Certificate teaching levels 4, 5 or 6 are awarded based on education, course credit hours (majors or minors in teachable subjects), practice teaching hours, and pedagogical training hours.^{a,b}

Early Childhood Educators

Level 1: Early Childhood Education Certificate in Early Childhood Education, related degree in Early Childhood Development, or unrelated degree conferred by a recognized post-secondary institution^b

Entry Level: A 90-hour Introduction to Early Childhood Education online course^c
