Regulated Child Care	<p><i>Nunavut Early Learning and Child Care Quality Framework</i>^b is grounded in Inuit societal values and Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit, a set of knowledge, values, and beliefs that are core to Inuit culture in Nunavut. The framework is also anchored in the values and beliefs of inunnguiniq, or the “making of a human being”.</p>
